Proprietary p3 technology features an optically pure adhesive system for cold laminating and is compatible with all types of digital or traditional output. This includes aqueous and solvent ink jet and HP Indigo digital offset as well as CIBA Chrome, LightJet and Durst Lambda prints. Our virtually invisible surface eliminates glare and bronzing and cleans up beautifully with a dry micro fiber cloth, even small scuffs and scratches disappear.

Film	2 mil Cast Polyolefin Polymer Blend. Features superior optical clarity and anti-reflective properties.
Adhesive	1.5 mil ultra clear, UV stabilized, high performance permanent acrylic pressure sensitive adhesive. Features smooth, even flow out characteristics for easy application, superior enviromental resistance, resistance to edge lift and slippage and is superior to any other laminate for application to smooth photo and art papers.
Liner	3 mil polyester liner.
Service Temperature Range	32°F to 200°F (0°C to 93°C). This is not a laminator setting.
Application Temperature	Minimum 50°F (10°C)
Ink Compatibility	Compatible with all types of inkjet printing including aqueous, solvent and HP Electroink.
Main Application	Smooth surfaces; Photo Paper (RC/ FB), Photo Film (PET, PPY), Inkjet Paper
Laminator Compatibility	Compatible with most hot and cold laminators. A take-up roller for the release liner is recommended. Most roll sizes are on a 3" core.
Laminator Settings	No heat is recommended. Apply 40 to 80 psi nip pressure and use 2 to 5 fpm dwell time depending on the application. Top and bottom web tension should be minimal so as not to induce curl.
Finishing	Ideally, the lamination should be allowed to cure for 24 hours before trimming. With a freshly sharpened blade, cut using a straight edge on tempered glass.
Storage Conditions	50-85°F, 40-60% RH. Store in origina packaging.
Shelf Life	Greater than one year from ship date when stored in proper conditions.
