Product Notes	<p><b>To mount items with irregular edges:</b> Apply Versamount to back of item, laying item face-up on a sheet of release paper and covering with kraft paper. Remove from press and carefully separate. Versamount will adhere to back of item while excess adhesive is removed by kraft paper. Re-mount to substrate in usual manner.</p> <p><b>To remove Versamount:</b> Place mounted image between sandwich of release paper and re-insert in press at usual temperature for approximately one minute. Upon removal, immediately but carefully separate image from substrate by lifting one edge and peeling back. Do not continue to peel if you meet resistance. Instead, re-insert in the press. Repeat this step as many times as required to remove all of the Versamount.</p>
